

... shall enjoy the same who shall enjoy the same  
 and under the plantation committing no least and performing all such  
 matters and things at his entry thereupon as by this act required until  
 the said Captain comes to age and the said person to Captain by the  
 Justice of the Peace in possession as aforesaid shall in the name and to the use of  
 the said Captain bring his action of debt against the former guardian  
 for the damages by him committed and the <sup>Commissioner</sup> Justice of the Peace  
 County and County obliged to give the same in Charge every June  
 Court to the said Captain by and on the penalty of Sixteen hundred  
 pounds of Tobacco and half thereof to her Majesty her heirs and  
 Successors for the Support of Government the other half to him or  
 them that shall sue for the same to be recovered in the provincial Court  
 by the plaintiff or informers within no Effray probation or wages of  
 Law to be allowed.

And be it further ENACTED by the authority aforesaid by and  
 with the Advice and Consent aforesaid that the Governor and respective  
 Deputy Comissaryes which now and shall be in the Province and res-  
 pective Counties within this Province shall and are hereby sufficiently  
 authorized and empowered to pass audits and allow all such accounts  
 as shall come before them relating to the admeas Estates within they  
 have granted Letters of Administration and Letters Testamentary  
 not exceeding fifty pounds Sterl. and to transmit such accounts within  
 two months to the Comissary Generals Office at Amapoti under the pe-  
 nalty of two thousand pounds of Tobacco and half to her Majesty for  
 the Support of Government and the other half to the party that shall pass such account  
 and to transmit the same to the Comissary General for which passing  
 such account the said Deputy Comissary shall be allowed as a fee the  
 sume of fifty pounds of Tobacco and no more and if such Deputy  
 Comissary as aforesaid shall exact demand or receive of any person what so-  
 ever more than is by this Law for executing such his Office allowed then  
 he shall be liable to such pains and penalty as are included in a certain  
 Act for limiting Officers fees in this Province but in case it shall so happen  
 that any person or persons having <sup>any</sup> interest or claim in such Estates  
 present in any Questions to the Legality or Justice of any Act or
