such Devise or of the Rest & part of all her husband's Estate off
which she is in deoable And if she accept of no 2 dower she shall be
for ever debarred of her Dower out of the rest of his Estates wch & Pts
aforesaid And if the accept of her Dower has not been accepted she
be adjudged a full recompence of her devise aforesaid and shall
so devised as aforesaid to such widow or wife shall be ^{always} entitled
to her but for life except it be expressly devised for ever or to such
woman and her heirs or to such woman and her Affins.

And by &c i further Enacted by the Authority Advice and
Consent aforesaid that every woman who since the twenty & second
day of June One thousand & Six hundred Ninety nine having had any
part of her Husband's personall Estate given or devised to her by her hus-
band in his last will and testament or Edicte and leaving no part
of her said Husband's land or real Estate devised to her share by such
Bequeath and devise of any part of the personall Estate except so
mentioned in such will or Edicte aforesaid be debarred of her Dower of
his Land but that if no Dower be assigned her she may notwithstanding
the said Act now demand or sue for her Dower and the man
profite thereof if she have been defrauded contrary to the intent of this
Act. PROVIDED always that if any married woman shall have any
Estate left upon her by her husband or other before Marriage
such Estate or Settlement shall bear her of her Dower of her Husband's
Land yet it shall be lawfull for her to accept what her Husband shall by
his last will and testament devise her.

And whereas many Complaints have greatly suffered by the second
marriage of such widows who having Estates in possession by wife or
right of Administration either by such widow's wife or her husband
during the continuall same have been wasted and imbezled and if the
woman by her said husband refused to render an account of such Estates
alleging that he is neither Executor or Administratoe to his wife nor of
her former husband whereas a Common Law a woman Court Jurisdiction can
do no Act to prejudice her husband at such acts during the same being done
without his consent he not preventing such waste when in his power ought to
be done for his service
