

35 Upon due proof thereof as aforesaid if such creditors have
 have paid debts of an inferior nature not recovered against them by
 of Law or sufficient Judgment to go against them for any such debts
 without paying such Foreign Debt in full of Judgment such creditors
 creditor not having assets in his or their hands sufficient to pay the debt
 aforesaid and satisfy the same the Court before whom such action shall
 be brought shall give Judgment and award Execution against such creditors or
 Administrators do bonis propriis to such Creditor or Creditors as aforesaid as the
 in that case directs anything in this present Act to the contrary thereof in any
 wise notwithstanding.

An Act for the Marking of Highways &

*making the heads of Rivers Creeks Branches and Swamps passable
 Horse and foot.*

Whereas it is thought convenient and very much for the benefit of the
 Inhabitants of this province that Roads and paths be made and the heads of
 Creeks and Branches be made passable.

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor with the Advice and Consent of the
 Council of this province and the authority of the same that all persons
 who shall be appointed by the Governor and will be bound for the same.
