

Be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that the booty -  
 prize passage or plunder of any Indian or other Savage or taken prisoner  
 shall by the Commander be equally divided and distributed amongst the soldiers  
 by a Division or distribution to be made by the said Commander and for the encouragement  
 of such Soldiers as shall adventure their Lives in the Service and Defence  
 of this Province and for the provision of some reasonable pension to be for  
 the future settled on such Soldiers as shall happen to be maimed or rendered  
 incapable to gett a livelihood for them selves or family.

Be it enacted by the Authority aforesaid that every person of  
 shall adventure as a Soldier in any War in defence of this Province and  
 shall therein happen to be maimed or receive hurt so as to be rendered in-  
 capable of getting a livelihood as aforesaid shall according to his disa-  
 bility receive yearly pension to be raised out of the publick Treasury of this Pro-  
 vince for the time being of such Disability and every person slain in the  
 Service of this Province leaving behind him a wife and Children shall also  
 be allowed a competent pension to the wife during her widowhood and the  
 Children till they be of years able to get their living or be put out Appren-  
 tices and that this pension be yearly paid and allowed out of the fifty  
 thousand pounds of Tobacco or Amun to be raised by the Governour of this  
 Province for the time being or the Council as in this Act is hereafter provided  
 in the intervals of Assen by the party petitioning for such pension and also in  
 procuring a Certificate from the County Court where he or she or they live that they  
 or they are ~~defendants~~ Objects of Charity and deserv to have such pension  
 and allowance.

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that in  
 upon any foreign Invasion any person or persons whatsoever except to see any  
 that shall be pressed or be an enlisted Soldier within this Province shall upon  
 the Command of his Officer being a Captain at the least obstinately refuse to go  
 and serve in arms for the necessary defence of this Province such person or persons  
 so obstinately refusing to appear and serve in arms as aforesaid shall by  
 Certificate thereof under such Officers hand as aforesaid to the next Justice of
