# An Act for Paying an Imposition on Several Com- modities exported out of this province

Be it Enacted by the Queen's most excellent Majesty by  
and with the Advice and Consent of her Majesty's Privy Council and  
Assembly of this province and the Authority of the said that from and after  
the publication hereof no person or persons what soever inhabiting or residing  
within this province shall export any Bees or Hives within this Act hereafter  
mentioned and expressed but what he she or they shall pay unto her Majesty  
her Heirs and Successors to be employed towards the Maintaining of Free Schools  
or Schoolers within this province the several duties and impositions hereafter following  
that is to say for every Bees or Hives four pence Sterling for Bees or four pence for Hives for  
every Hives or Beehive four pence Sterling for young Bees and Cull Hives two pence  
per Hives And that all non Residents from and after the publication hereof that shall  
export out of this province any Bees or Hives herein before mentioned and expressed  
shall for every Hives or Beehive exported of what nature or quality soever be  
comprized within this Act pay unto her Majesty her Heirs and Successors for the use  
aforesaid double the duty by this Act appointed to be paid by persons inhabiting  
or residing within this province as aforesaid the same several impositions  
collected by the several and respective Naval Officers within this province
