

A. 91. Act for the Encouragement of the
Practice and Relief of poor Doctors.

Be it enacted by His Queen most Excellent Majesty by and with the Advice and Consent of Her Majestys Governor Council and Assembly of this province and the Authority of Her Royal Highness the Queen or persons Inhabitants of this province who after the end of this Session of Assembly shall be indebted to any person or persons whatsoever inhabitants of this province in any sum or sums of money or quantity of Tobacco by Pound or Pds. or Account or value, having Judgment or Judgments given and entered against them in any Court of Record within this province it shall and may be —

Pawful for such Doctor or Doctors respectively to pay and discharge themselves from such Debts and Judgments when they have not the Specie for which the said Judgments are given by the Booksale —
Hhings following being of the greatest and production of this —
provinne (that is to say) Beef in wte was one Caisg tare and
the same in flat board Butt Merchantable and were Paied at —
three half pence per pound for by in wte Barred Barrels or other
Caisgs tare and the same in flat board Butt Merchantable and were
Paied at two pence per pound Bacon at three pence half penny —
per pound Dried Beef at three pence per pound Wheat at three
Shillings Six pence per bushell Oats at two Shillings per bushell Pease by
at two Shillings per bushell Indian Corn at one Shilling Eight pence per
bushell pease at three Shillings Six pence per bushell Peas at —
Half bushel Three Shillings Six pence per bushell and the prices of the above said
commodities by this act agreed and required to be paid by the Doctor or Doctor in full discharge
of his said Debts and Judgments is allowed and paid at any and
convenient place in the County.

And it is further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid
and Consent aforesaid that in case any Doctor or Doctors who
