

1^o a few said shall be paid in ready money as aforesaid that then the Importers or Importers shall forfeit the said Liqueur or value thereof in ready money to the use aforesaid to be recovered as aforesaid

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that when the Importer and importer aforesaid have made full duty as aforesaid and paid the duty as aforesaid in ready money as aforesaid that then the Naval Officer shall give the said Importer a permit to carry the same to any River, River or Harbour or port or place of this province to make sale of the same.

provided always that if any person or persons shall import any the Liqueur aforesaid from Pennsylvania aforesaid in Sloops or other vessels by Sea through the Cape of Chesapeake into this province that then such Importer or Importers shall owe the duty of three pence per gallon as aforesaid and after the same manner as is mentioned in a certain Act of Parliament of this province Intituled An Act imposing three pence per gallon on Rum and wine and twenty Shillings per pole for Negroes for raising a Supply to defray the publick Charges of this province and twenty Shillings per pole for Irish Servants to prevent the Importing too great a Number of Irish papists into this province.

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid ~~by and with~~ the Advice and Consent aforesaid that the Naval Officer aforesaid for the said Duty of three pence per gallon aforesaid shall account to the publick Treasurer of this eastern shere shall account to the generall Assembly of this province in manner and form as is mentioned in the aforesaid Act Intituled An Act imposing three pence per gallon on Rum and wine and twenty Shillings per pole for Negroes for raising a Supply to defray the publick Charges of this province and twenty Shillings per pole for Irish Servants to prevent the Importing too great a Number of Irish papists into this province.

And lastly be it Enacted that the said Naval Officer shall make oath before his or her Governour or whom the Governour shall impower to administer such oath that the said Naval Officer shall use his utmost power and diligence to cause this Act ~~of the~~ effectually to be put in Execution and a Certificate of such oath taken shall be entered upon the Council Book.
