

Orders of her Majesty's Governour Council and Assembly of this  
province and the Authority of the same that from and after the  
publication thereof all Masters of Ships and Vessels or others importing  
Irish Servants into this province by Land or by Water at the time of  
their Entry shall pay unto the Naval Officer for the time being being  
going to such port or place where they make their Entry the sum of  
twenty shillings per pole towards the Defraying the publick Charges  
of this province for every Irish Servant so imported on penalty and  
forfeiture of five pounds Sterling for every Servant so imported at  
the time of his Entry aforesaid the one half thereof to be appropriated  
to the uses aforesaid the other half to the informer or him or them  
that shall sue for the same to be recovered in the Majesty's Court  
Court of Record within this province by action of Debt Bill Plaint or  
information without need of Juyr protection or wager of Law to be  
allowed.

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid and Council  
aforesaid that for every Negro imported into this province either by  
Land or Water the Importer or Importers of such Negroes or Negroes shall  
pay unto the Naval Officer aforesaid the sum of twenty shillings  
per pole for the use aforesaid on penalty and forfeiture of five pounds  
per pole for every Negro kept back or unaccounted for to be applied  
for the use aforesaid to be recovered as aforesaid.

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid by and  
with the advice and Consent aforesaid that from and after the pu-  
-lication thereof all Masters of Ships or other Vessels that shall either by  
Land or Water import any Rume Brandy Spirits or Wine into this pro-  
-vince shall pay unto the Naval Officer aforesaid where they make their  
Entry the sum of three pence per gallon for every gallon of Rume Brandy  
Spirits or Wine so imported into this province as aforesaid to be applied  
to the uses aforesaid (Liquor from England always excepted).

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid and Council  
aforesaid that no Rume Brandy Spirits or Wine upon which the Duty aforesaid  
are assessed shall be landed or put on shore out of any Ship or other Vessel  
which shall import <sup>the same</sup> or any other without due Entry thereof with the Officer  
(the same)
