

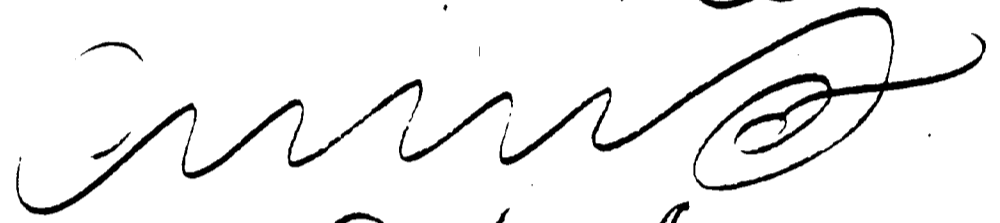

An Act Impowering the Commissioners of the County Courts
to Levy and raise Tobacco to pay the necessary Charges of their
County and parishes.

Be it Enacted by the Queens most excellent Majesty by and with
the Advice and Consent of her Majestys Governour Council and Assembly of
this Province and the Authority of the same That for the future it shall and
may be lawfull to and for the severall and respective Commissioners of the seve-
rall and respective County Courts within this Province at their severall and
respective County Courts to be holden for their said County upon Examination
had before them of the publick Charges of their severall and respective Coun-
ties and allowances by them made of the same to Levy and raise Tobac-
co for payment and Satisfaction of the severall and respective County Charges
and the Sheriffs Salary for Collecting thereof by an equal Assessment
the said persons of the said severall County any former Law Use
or Custom to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding.

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid and in
aforesaid that the Clerk of each respective County within this Province
