

93 That upon calling every general assembly for this province for the
 issue to the Sheriff of every such County within the same shall be made
 and made into a County as aforesaid and to the Mayor Recorder and
 Aldermen of every such City or Burrough Commanding such Sheriff or
 Mayor Recorder and Aldermen to Cause four Freeholders of the said County
 and two freeholders of the said City or Burrough Qualified as in the
 Writ is expressed to serve as Delegates and Representatives of the said
 County City or Burrough in the general assembly then next ensuing which
 said four Delegates for every such County and two for the City and Burrough
 shall be prominent for the County and be reputed and esteemed to be Members of the
 House of the general assembly of this province any thing in this Act
 to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding.

provided also that no Ordinary Keeper within this province
 during the time of his keeping Ordinary shall be elected Chosen or sworn
 as a Deputy or Representative in the said general assembly so to be then
 called convened and appointed as aforesaid.
