

Be it enacted by the Queen most Excellent Majesty  
 by and with the advice and Consent of the said Majesty's Honourable Council  
 and Assembly of this present and the validity of the said that  
 all writs pleas process Judgments Informations Bills Rules Accords  
 Judgments Decrees and Sentences awarded of or concerning any  
 Matter or thing whatsoever which was sued or prosecuted to Judgment  
 in any of the Courts of Record Chancery Admiralty or Commissary Courts  
 within this province at any time or times since the first day of April in  
 the year of our Lord one thousand five hundred and ninety to the  
 tenth day of May One thousand five hundred ninety two And also  
 Writs pleas process Bills Rules Accords Judgments Informations  
 Judgments Decrees and Sentences awarded of or concerning any  
 Matter or thing whatsoever which was sued or prosecuted to  
 Judgment in any of the Courts of Record Chancery Commissary and  
 Admiralty Courts within this province at any time or times from  
 the death of his Excellency Luorell Coppy Esq. late Governor of  
 this province to the arrival of his Excellency Francis Nicholson Esq.  
 Governour thereof shall be good and effectual in the law to all  
 Intents Constructions and purposes whatsoever any discontinuance  
 of process or other defects in the said proceedings notwithstanding

And be it further enacted by the Authority Advice  
 and Consent aforesaid that all Writs pleas process Accords Bills Rules  
 Judgments Informations Judgments Decrees and Sentences given or  
 awarded of and concerning any Matter or thing whatsoever which  
 was sued or prosecuted to Judgment in any of the Courts of Record Chancery  
 Commissary and Admiralty Courts within this province at any time or times  
 from the demise of his late Majesty King William the third of blessed  
 Memory to the end of this Session of Assembly notwithstanding the want  
 of any Jurisdiction or authority in the said Courts shall be good and effectual  
 in the law to all Intents Constructions and purposes whatsoever

provided always that this Act or any thing therein contained shall  
 not be construed to extend to take away such errors in law as shall or may arise  
 upon issuing of process mispleading and erroneous rendering of Judgment  
 (in point)
