

104 yearly and every year having sundry such respective Ordinary
Keepers within their respective Counties them and there to set and
assess the Rates and prizes of all Liquors and other Accommodations
whatsoever by them the said Ordinary Keepers to be levied for the year
ensuing and so yearly and every year. Which rates and prizes of all Liquors
to be set and assessed limited and appointed by the Justices aforesaid
shall be by their several and respective Clerks transcribed and set up at
their several and respective County Courts in some publick place there
that every person or persons may peruse the same the Copy of which tables
of prizes of Liquors and accommodations every Ordinary Keeper within
each County are hereby obliged to transcribe fairly and keep the same
set up in the most publick place of their houses for the perusal of all
persons that receive any Ordinary Accommodations from them under the
penalty of one thousand pounds of Tobacco to her Majesty her heirs
and Successors to be applyed to the use of the County where such Ordinary
Keeper shall live to be sued for non payment thereof in the
Majestys name for which Summe and table of prizes every Ordinary
Keeper shall pay to such Ward the Summe of forty pounds of Tobacco and
no more; And every Ordinary Keeper or Inhabitant that shall after
the setting up and assessing the Rates and prizes aforesaid directly or
indirectly take exact demand or receive for the price and pay for any
such Liquors or other Accommodations for which the Rates and prizes
shall be assessed and set as aforesaid of any person or persons what-
soever above the Rates and prizes so set and assessed as aforesaid shall
for every such Account sued for taken or received forfeit and pay
the Summe of five hundred pounds of Tobacco one half thereof to her
Majesty her heirs and Successors for the use of the County the other
half to him or them that shall inform or sue for the same and tooke
every such Debt or Account sued for taken or received to unjustly charged
exacted and demanded the said forfeitures to be recovered in any Court
of Record within this province by bill Plaint or Information where in nec-
essary protection or Wager of Law to be allowed.

And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid
that every Ordinary Keeper or Inhabitant so to be Licensed as aforesaid shall
within six months after granting their respective Licenses be hereby obliged
