

1704. In the same Recon or Actions within the Land as is before mentioned
Then coming to the sume of fullage found memory at large or recovered from
The said Rec as other persons having no such Improvement might or should
have done.

And forasmuch as divers disputes formerly arose whether persons
abreiling the province or wandering from County to County until the time by Law
set for the year and purpose aforesaid limited and allowed were ex-
empted from any Benefit thereby and different Judgments given —
Wherein the several and respective Counties within this province for that
the said Act was a Negation of Right.

Be it therefore Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that from
and after the publication hereof No person or persons whatsoeuer abroiling
themselves out of this province or shall remov. & from County to County after
any Debt contracted whereby the Creditor or Creditors may be at uncertainty of
finding out the said person or persons or his or their Effects shall have any benefit

by the Limitation and Restriction in this Act specified.

Provided always that it is the true intent and Meaning hereof
that this Act restraining herein contained shall not be construed to extend
to any to precide or release any person removing himself or himself from
one County to another for his Conveniency or any person having this province
for his home and living in this old Limited from the Benefit hereof the
having effects sufficient and sufficient for the payment of his just Debts in his
hands of some person or persons who will assume the payment thereof to his
Creditors anything in this act contained to the contrary being in any wise not
withstanding.

And Be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid by and with
the Advice and Consent aforesaid that no Bill Bond Judgment Decree or
Statute Merchant &c of the staple or other Specialty whatsoever shall be good
payable or admitted in Evidence against any person or persons of this province
after the principal Debtor and Creditor have been both dead two years or
longer or living indecom above two years standing.
