Provided always that no person shall be prosecuted upon this act for profane cursing and swearing unless the same be proved and prosecuted within ten days after the offence committed.

And be it enacted by the Authority aforesaid and with the Advice and Consent aforesaid that every Justice of the peace or other officer before whom such Cursing or Swearing and Cursing shall happen to be shall receive the forfeitures aforesaid and shall give account thereof at the time of the paying of Each County Levy.
