

Provided always that nothing in this Act contained shall be construed
intended to make any Inhabitant or Householder liable to any Damage which
shall or may happen to any Tobacco so left with him to buy or sell through any other
Casualty whatsoever.

And be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid by and with the Advice
and Consent aforesaid that any person or persons whatsoever Merchants or others
within this Province shall have at any time within twelve Months last past Received
Marked or Marked or for the future shall receive Marked or Marked any Hoghead or Hogheads

*In Satisfaction of their said Debts and such Merchants or others upon receipt marking and sealing such Hoghead or Hogheads of
Tobacco delivered to them which shall have been paid and delivered to them for sale or other security to their respective*

Debtors of their said Debts or if the said Merchants or others have given orders or
Discharges to their said Debtors of the said Debt and that before the said Merchant
or others could remove the said Hoghead or Hogheads of Tobacco from the said
Debtors Tobacco House if any Sheriff shall come and seize such Tobacco so marked
and named as aforesaid that then and in every such Case if the party refuse to
make and give to the said Creditor some other full Satisfaction for their said
Debt it shall and may be lawful for any two of our Majestys Justices of the respective
Counties within this Province upon due proof thereof made before them of the
said Debt and then to seize as aforesaid and the party Debtor refusing to make
that full Satisfaction to their Creditor for their said Debt at the said Creditors request
to award him Execution with Costs such Costs not exceeding One hundred pounds of
Tobacco against the body goods and Chattels of such Debtor to be executed by the
Sheriff for Satisfaction of the Creditors just Debt and Costs as aforesaid in as full and
amplie manner as if the Debt were recovered by due Course of Law.
