

or Bayler as any person or persons shall be taking or detaining or carrying
or made before him in his County in any such or such depending action
to be depending in the said provincial Court which Recognizance shall be
taken in such manner and form as followeth viz

John Doe plaintiff of you A. B. and C. D. and either of you do under
against Richard Roe Defendant in
pounds of Tobacco to be levied on your and either of
your Lands & Tenements goods & Chattels to the use of the said John Doe the
plaintiff upon condition that if the said John Doe do obtain Judgment in an
action of Debt or Trespass upon the Case depending in the provincial Court
against the said Richard Roe the Defendant that then the said Richard Roe
shall pay the Condemnation or deliver himself to the prison of our Sovereign
Lady the Queen or you will do it for him. They acknowledge themselves to be
Content therewith this day of before me.

To the Honourable Justice of the provincial Court
Which said Recognizance of Bayle or Bayle prizes so taken as aforesaid
shall be transmitted to the Justice of the provincial Court sitting when and
where such action or suits shall be depending. Which Recognizance or Recogni-
zance of Bayle prizes so taken as aforesaid the said Court shall receive upon
payment of such fees as have been received for the taking of such special
Bayle by the Officers of the said Court and shall be of the like force and effect
as if the same were taken & given before the Justice of the provincial
Court during their sitting for taking of every such Recognizance or Recogni-
zance of Bayle or Bayle prizes such Justice of the provincial Court or
president of the County Court that shall take such Bayle shall receive only
the sum of five Shillings and no more.

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid
the Justice of the provincial Court that make such Rules and orders for the
regulating of such Bayles and making the same absolute as to them shall
meet so as the Cognizor or Cognizers of such Bayle or Bayles be not
to appear in person in the provincial Court to justify them or indemnify
