All such articles and conditions of Tobacco

Exportation of the same
shall be as follows

As it enacted by the Queen most excellent Majesty and
with the advice and consent of the Majesty's honorable Council and assembly
of this province and the authorities aforesaid that what person or
persons shall make or cause to be made for his use any
Tobacco pipe or pipes which shall exceed forty eight inches
in length of the pipe and thirty two inches in the head to be made
or shall make or cause to be made for his use any Tobacco
pipe or pipes under the size of forty eight inches in length
and thirty inches in the head and the same pipe or pipes or any of them
shall pay for the same the sum of five pounds of Tobacco of which he is duty to the Majesty his heirs
and successors for the support of the Government of this province and the
other duties on them that are by the said Majesty and Council thereof
to be paid and the same shall be made to be entered in the books
of the
