

An Act for the securing persons right to their Lands -

Whereas it is represented to the General Assembly that several persons of
this province and others have taken up Lots in several Town Lands laid out
and surveyed for Towns according to the direction of several Laws of this province
(that is to say) One Law made at a General Assembly held at New Bedford
Academy County the second day of October One thousand six hundred and forty
three intituled an Act for Advancement of Trade and the Colonie Act made at
a General Assembly held at the City of Saint Marys the first day of April
Sixteen hundred and eighty four intituled an Additional and Supplementary
Act to the Act for Advancement of Trade and the other Act made at a
General Assembly held at the City of Saint Marys the twenty seventh day
of October One thousand six hundred and eighty five intituled a further
Additional Act to the Act for Advancement of Trade and the Supple-
mentary Act of the same and one other act made at a Session of Assembly
Bogum and held at the City of Saint Marys the twenty first day of September
Anno Domini Sixteen hundred Ninety four intituled an Act for Erecting Am-
erundale and Oxford Towns into ports and Towns as by the several Acts of
Assembly remaining upon Record in the Secretarys Office of this province
may appear. And notwithstanding the several persons who willing and
depending upon the benefits and privileges in the said Laws granted
have taken up Lots in the said Towns owned them and paid for them
or were ready to pay for them as the Law directed and provided and imposed
know ye that they are now treated disquieted and disturbed by the persons
claiming rights to the said Lands upon pretence that because that the
said Acts are since repealed the titles of such taken up Builders and In-
spectors are destroyed and dye with the said Act of Trade contrary to the true
Sense and rational Construction of the same Laws or any other of the Nature
to prevent know how and take off such unnecessary trouble and scrups therof.

Be it Enacted by the Queens most excellent Majestie by and with the
advice and consent of her Majesties Governor Council and Assembly of this province
and the Authority of the same that he and every person or persons that during
the continuall of the before mentioned Acts of Assembly did take up pay for
