Customs grant to the Company in any way...
The Lord Proprietary and his heirs...
of this province under the yearly rent of one Beaver Skin to be paid...
his said Lordship and his heirs as other Rents within provinces by the
English used to be paid.

provided always that it shall not may be lawful for any
person or persons that shall formerly take any and obtain any part
from the Lord Baltimore for any Tracts or parcels of Land within the
aforesaid Boundaries upon the Indians deserting or leaving the said
Land to enter occupy and enjoy the same any thing in this Law to
the contrary notwithstanding.

And be it further Enacted by the Authority
aforesaid that it shall not nor may be lawful for the Lord Baltimore
to ask have or demand any Rent or Service for any of the said Tracts
or dividends as may or have been taken up as aforesaid within the said
Indians Boundaries until such time that the said Tracts upon Owners aforesaid
do enjoy or possess the same any Law usage or Custom to the contrary
notwithstanding.
