

145 Government or Charge and Administration and Succession.

Custom or Grant to the contrary in any way notwithstanding in or to the said Proprietary and his heirs, Lords, Agents or Assigns, or any of this Province under the great Seal of our Governor shall be paid, or his said Lordship and his heirs, as other Rents within Province by the English use to be paid.

provided always that it shall and may be lawful for any person or persons that shall hereafter take any and demand any part from the said Baltimore for any Tracts or parcels of Land within the said said Boundaries upon the Indians deserting or leaving the said Land to enter occupy and enjoy the same anything in this Law to the contrary notwithstanding.

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that it shall not nor may be lawful for the said Baltimore to ask, have or demand any Rent or Service for any of the said Tracts or divisions as may or have been taken up as aforesaid within the said Indians Boundaries until such time that the said Tracts upon whom they do enjoy or possess the same any Law usage or Custom to the contrary notwithstanding.
