said that any papish Bishop priest or Jesuite shall
exercise any Office or Function other than such who have papish
parents or shall say Mass or exercise the functions of a papish
Bishop or priest within this province or shall endeavour to per-
suade any of Her Majesty's Loyal people of this province to
embrace and be reconciled to the Church of Rome and shall
be shew of Legality Court shall forfeit the sum of fifty pound
sterling for every such offence the one half thereof to our Sovereign
Lady the Queen her heirs and Successors for the support of the
Government of this province and the other half thereof to
him or them that will sue for the same to be recovered in any
Court of Record within this province by bill plaint or information
wherewith no Stay protection or liager of Law to be allowed and
shall also suffer six months imprisonment of his or their bodies
without Bayle or Mainprize.

And be it further Enacted by and with the
advice Consent and Authority aforesaid that if any papish Bishop
priest or Jesuit after such Excommunication aforesaid shall say Mass or
exercise any other part of the Office or Function of a papish Bishop or
priest within this province or if any papist or person making
profession of a papish Religion shall keep Schools or take upon
themselves the Education Government or Boarding of Youth in
any place within this province such person ~~and~~ ^{as} ~~shall~~ ^{shall} be convicted
thereof shall upon Excommunication
be banished out of this province to the Kingdom of England
together with his Excommunication in order to his suffering such pains and
penalties as are provided by the Statute made in the Eleventh and
twelfth year of the reign of our late Majesty King William the Third
(Enacted)
