This Act is rendered Obsolete

All. Act for publication of Marriages.

Be it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majestie by
and with the Advice and Consent of her Majesties Governor Council and
Assembly of this province And the Authority of the same that all persons who
desire Marriage shall apply themselves either to a Minister pastor or
Registrars for the Contracting thereof.

And Be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid by an
with the Advice and Consent aforesaid that all persons within this province
intending Marriage shall make publication thereof either at the Church-
Chappell County Court or Meeting house next where they dwell and shall set
imination such Church Chappell or Meeting house shall be fit and knowleg-
capable to take Conuiance thereof and that it shall and may be lawfull upon
part from the Minister pastor or County Court where such publication shall be done
made three weekes after the said publication for the Minister pastor or Registrar
(where no Minister can be had to performe marriage) such persons as aforesaid
any person shall presume to contract marriage without such publication or
Certificate therof had as aforesaid or without particularlie affirme
for the Union being so privately within the limits of this province
every person so contracted or married shall be lyable to the fine of one
