made saving what are here by expressed

Be it enacted by the Queen's most excellent Majesty by and with  
the advice and consent of her Majesty's Governor Council and Judges  
of this Province and the Authority of the same that all and every certain  
Acts of Assembly of this Province made and enacted at any time before  
this Session of Assembly begun and hold at the port of Annapolis the twenty  
sixth day of April One thousand seven hundred and four except the Act  
intituled an Act for the Establishment of Religious Worship within this  
Province according to the Church of England and for the maintenance of  
Ministers and except the Act for keeping good rules and orders in the port  
of Annapolis and which are not revised passed and enacted this present  
Session of Assembly be and are hereby repealed and made void they  
always to all and every person or persons whatsoever was and is in  
their rights and benefits which he or they had by the former Acts of  
Assembly any thing in this present Act contained to the contrary notwithstanding.
