

158 For serving a writ and capias and thirty five pounds of Tobacco for  
leading a prisoner out of the County twenty five pounds of Tobacco for  
of Tobacco and for pro rate for a longer time for collecting the said  
for every hundred ten pounds of Tobacco for serving an attachment or  
Execution ten pounds of Tobacco and if any Execution be for a bare one  
hundred and under five hundred pounds of Tobacco fifty pounds of  
Tobacco if it exceed five hundred pounds of Tobacco then one hundred  
pounds of Tobacco if it exceed one thousand then for the first thousand  
one hundred pounds of Tobacco and every thousand afterward fifty  
pounds of Tobacco for Commitment and Detachment forty pounds of  
Tobacco for pillory and Whipping nothing allowed and after the same  
rate for Money or Tobacco and it is hereby declared that it is the true  
Intent and meaning of this Act the several Statutes shall have no more  
force that for what shall appear to be justly due upon such Execution  
and the same fees for buying any attachment for any sum what so ever  
money or Tobacco or the full value thereof in any goods or Merchandized  
provided the same be condemned to those of the party plaintiff attaching  
the same and pro rate for such part thereof as shall be condemned but if  
no part shall be condemned that shall be attached that then the said Sheriff  
shall receive only ten pounds of Tobacco for retaining the writ aforesaid &  
no more for Impaneling a Jury one hundred and twenty pounds of  
Tobacco for serving any extraordinary Warrant or Commission to be regulated  
by the Court for serving a fieri facias including the persons summoned thirty  
pounds of Tobacco for serving a Citation thirty pounds of Tobacco for  
Executing a Commission of Deputary of Day one hundred pounds of Tobacco  
for Impaneling a Jury two hundred and forty pounds if empowered to  
swear Jury and Evidence then for every oath two pounds of Tobacco  
for every non est returned ten pounds of Tobacco for serving a  
Subpoena thirty pounds of Tobacco for Commitment and Detachment forty  
pounds of Tobacco but for Whipping and pillory nothing allowed  
To the Coroner for viewing the body of any person or persons murdered  
him or otherwise dead by Misadventure to be made out of the goods &  
Receives of the party so dead if any there be otherwise to be levied by the  
jurors of the County where such accident shall happen two hundred &
