

And it is further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that
all Boats belonging to this Province and being under Licence for by
the Goods shall pass and repass without any Lett Hindrance Molesta-
tion or Seizure of the same (unto which shall carry and have on board
them prohibited goods or goods liable to pay Custom to her Ma^{ty}
not Requested or bearing for the same without being obliged to
take out permits for such passing or repassing as aforesaid and that
the Masters of all Gallies or open Boats trading within this
Province do pay to the severall Naval Officers or their Deputy or
Deputy appointed for the granting of permits the sum of
two shillings six pence yearly and no more for the granting such
permits as aforesaid and shall give good Security to be taken by
such Officers aforesaid or their Deputy or Deputy in their Masters
Name that he and they shall well duly observe the Acts
of Trade and Navigation and other good Laws of this Province
relating thereto.

And it is further Enacted that all and every
Collector and Collectors of this Province shall have and receive such Fees
for entering and bearing such Ships and Vessels aforesaid as are above
allowed to the Naval Officers and no more and that all Collectors or
Naval Officers shall make a fair Table of their Fees and hang up in
their Offices under the penalty of fifty pounds to her Majesty
her Heires and Successors for the Support of Government to be recovered
in any Court of Record within this Province by Action of Debt Bill
Plaint or Information without any delay or protection or benefit of
Law to be allowed.

It is provided always that in Case any person shall
refuse to pay the same so by this Act Limited and allowed it shall
be lawful for the Chancery Secretary or the Secretary of the
