

of the Council Court of the Court of Appeals the several Courts of the  
County Courts (viz) of the provincial Court and the several Courts of the  
County Courts to recover the same by way of Execution against the  
Goods Tobacco or Chattels of the person or persons so refused and no other  
provided always that such person or persons having no Tobacco and  
that shall refuse to show unto such Officer or Officers as shall collect  
the same such goods and Chattels it shall be lawful for such Officer or  
Officers to take the body or bodies of such person or persons in Execution  
for the same provided also that no Officer or Officers in this Act specially  
mentioned and whose Fees are hereby settled and Limited shall by colour  
thereof either have or cause to be done any Execution upon the body  
Goods or Chattels of any person or persons whatsoever for any Fees  
in this Act Limited and Contained without delivering or causing to be  
delivered a true and just account of the Fees to them due by this Act  
as aforesaid under the hand or hands of such Officer or Officers to the  
person or persons to whom such Fees demanded and due as aforesaid  
wholly at the least before Execution done and in case any  
of the said Officer or Officers as aforesaid shall in any wise act or do  
contrary directly or indirectly to this Act he or they so offending shall  
lose and forfeit to the party grieved twice damages sustained and shall  
also forfeit the sum of six thousand pounds of Tobacco aforesaid  
and shall show Majesty thereof to our Sovereign Lady the Queen her  
heirs and Successors for the support of Government to be recovered  
in her Majesty's name the other Majesty to the party or parties that  
shall sue for the same to be recovered in any Court of Record within  
this province by action of Debt bill plaint or Information without  
no other protection or Wager of Law to be allowed.

And it is further provided that if any person for any matter or  
thing hereafter to be done belonging to the Officers aforesaid shall be  
and Council so allowed and adjudged and not in this Act mentioned  
allowed and adjudged it shall be lawful for such Officer or Officers
