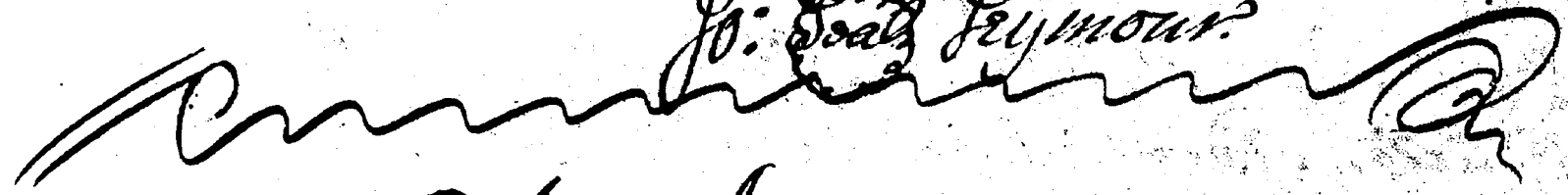

### An Act for Rebuilding the Stadthouse at Amoy.

Whereas William Staden of Amoy is by his  
his Executors & Administrators hath undertaken provided Govern-  
ment provided and agreed to and with the general assembly of this pro-  
-vided for and in consideration of five thousand pounds Sterling or in  
-Sollars or piece of eight at four Shillings and Six pence as they  
now pass within this province to be paid to him the said William  
Staden his Ex<sup>ors</sup> or adm<sup>rs</sup> and of all the old Iron Work Brick and Timber  
preserved from the fire when the said Stadthouse was burnt at this  
proper costs and charges to rebuild or cause to be rebuilt a new  
Stadthouse upon the walls and foundation of the said burnt Stad-  
-thouse and to complete and finish all Bricklayers Work Carpenters  
Work Joiners work Plasterers Work and Glaziers Work and furnish  
the said Stadthouse with rocks and Lye in the same full and approved  
manner and form as the said burnt Stadthouse was built complete  
finished and furnished at any time before it was burnt the said  
or more only excepted

Be it therefore Enacted by the Queen's  
Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of her Majesty's  
Governour Council and assembly of this province and the Council  
of the same that the said William Staden may receive
