at the Brick Store work and timber a few said and that out of the  
publick Stock of this province shall be payd to the said William

sterl or in Dollars or pieces of eight at four and six pence a piece  
as they now pass within this province.

Provided this Act shall not have effect till the  
said William Staden hath given good security to his Excellency  
the Governour of two thousand pounds sterl to perform the same  
within eighteen months.
