Be it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by  
with the Advice and Consent of her Majestys Governour Councill and  
Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same that the severall  
and respective Acts of Assembly hereafter made and enacted (that is to  
say) One Act Intituled An Act for Erecting Ambassadors and Exposed Towns  
into ports and Towns One other Act of Assembly Intituled An Act for the  
punishment of ~~persons~~ <sup>persons</sup> Suborning Witnesses or Comitting wilful and  
Corrupt perjury One other Act Intituled an Act for Banishing and Expelling  
out of the Lord Day commonly called Sunday One other Act Intituled An  
Act Concerning Indians One other Act Intituled An Act for the present  
Security of the Frontier plantations from the Inursions and violence  
of Indians One other Act Intituled An Act prohibiting Trade with the  
Indians for any flesh dead or alive except Deer and wild fowls One other  
Act Intituled an Act for Quieting Differences that may arise between  
his Majestys Subjects within this Province and the several Nations of  
Indians of what place soever and every Cause Matter and thing therein  
Contained is hereby declared to be and remain in full force and effect to all  
Intent and Construction and purposes what soever to the end of the next  
Session of Assembly this present Session not having Learners fully to  
Consider thereof.
