 as aforesaid and of this present Act be enabled quietly and peacefully to have
 enjoy a firm sure absolute and inseparable of inheritance in fee simple to
 them and their heirs for ever of in and to the said tract of Land against
 persons whatsoever

AND be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid and consent aforesaid
 that the said Nicholas Love shall out of the Consideration for which the said
 is to be sold satisfy and pay unto the said John Mitchell his Executors Admin-
 istrators or Assigns the said debt now due to him from the said William Dem-
 onson (if the said debt shall be paid for so much) and that the overplus (if any)
 shall remain in the hands of the said Nicholas Love after payment
 the said debt and deduction of his Salary by him shall be paid and conveyed
 to the Orphan to whom the said Land was given by the Last will and Testament
 of the said William Demondson and shall not be accounted as assets in the hands
 of the said Executor but be by virtue of this Act protected from all Attachments
 and Executions whatsoever any Law Statute or Usage or Custom to the contrary

 pay and discharge certain Debts of his said fathers contracted
