It is therefore humbly prayed that it may be enacted And so it
 enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice
 and consent of her Majesty's Governor Council and Assembly
 of this province and the authority of the same that all or any
 the said Grantes Bargainees and purchasers of any the said
 William Joseph the Elder's Lands within this province who actually
 bargained for the same with the said William Joseph the Son
 before the twelfth day of December in the year of Our Lord seven-
 teen hundred and three by virtue of the said William Joseph the Elder's
 letter of Attorney shall be the consequence or assurance of the said
 Joseph the Younger's purchase thereof notwithstanding any Imperfection
 or insufficiency of or in the said letter of Attorney or the wording thereof
 (this Assembly being made before the same was duly recorded)
 to all intents and purposes whatsoever save that and enjoy the
 said tenements and hereditaments to them their heirs and assigns
 forever any Law Statute Usage or Custom to the contrary not-
 withstanding ~

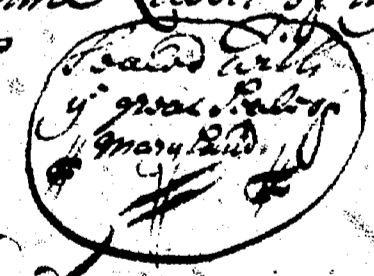
