An Act for punishment of persons selling or transporting
 any friend Indian or Indians out of this province.

So the end that no breach of peace may happen
 between the Neighbouring Indians and the Inhabitants of
 this province.

Be it Enacted by the Queen's most Excellent
 Majesty by and with the advice and consent of her Majesty's
 Governor Council and Assembly of this province and
 the Authority of the same that ^{any person or persons whatsoever that} shall take
 or transport or cause to be sold or transported out of this province
 Or otherwise dispose of any friend Indian or Indians what
 soever or endeavour or attempt to do without license from
 the Governor for the time being and all Accessories therein to
 shall be fined and Imprisoned at the discretion of the Gov.
 and Council for the time being and that any person or persons
 whatsoever that shall inform against or cause such Offenders
