Be it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of her Majesty's Governor Council and Assembly of this Province and the authority of the same that the Act of Assembly made at a generall Assembly begun and hold at the port of Annapolis the twenty seventh day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and five intituled an Act of: containing the Bounds of Land and every Clause matter and thing therein contained is hereby declared to be and remains in full force and effect to all intents constructions and purposes whatsoever to the end of the next Sessions of Assembly.
