

235 Exterior Bounds of this Province
of Queen Anns County and with the said
river to Eastern Neck where it first began and shall
contain all the Land within the said Bounds -

And that from and after the said first Day of 1711
One thousand seven hundred and seven Cecil County shall
contain all the Land on the north side of Parafra river
and Kent County and shall be bounded on the east and north
with the Exterior Bounds of this Province on the west
with the said Parafra river and Chesapeake Bay and on the
South with Parafra river and Kent County.

And Be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid
by and with the advice and Consent aforesaid that the
severall persons herein after mentioned nominated and
appointed shall be and are hereby authorized Impowered
and required to call to them the Surveyors of the severall and
respective County's aforesaid and cause them to run out lines and
Divisions of the said County's according to the directions
in this Act before mentioned (wherein they are not by nature
all bounds divided One from the other that is to say for
