An Act for Vesting and Settling Certain Lands
In John Whittington and his Heires Late the
Estate and Inheritance of a certain Daniell Toacs
for and towards Satisfaction and payment
of a debt Due from the said Toacs and paid by
the Jo Whittington -

Whereas John Whittington of Kent County Gent.
by his petition to this present Generall Assembly
hath sett forth that a certain Daniell Toacs late of
the said County Deceased being in his Lifetime In-
debted to a certaine Richard Swetnam Late of
Talbot County Deceased in the sume of thirty five
Thousand pounds of Tobacco & being Willing &
Desirous to have the same satisfied and payed by
his last will and Testament in writing did leave
severall tracts of Land to be sold for the payment
of his Debts and of his said will did constitute
and appoint his son Daniell Toacs his Executor &
Dyed after whose Death the said Daniell Toacs
the son & Executor suffered himself to be sued
for the said Debt Due to the said Swetnam and
being taken in Execution for the same did prevail
wth the said John Whittington and a certain Mi-
chael Miller since Deceased become security for
payment of the said Debt & cost that the said Dan^l
Toacs the son & Executor in some short time after dyed
Leaving the said Debt & cost wholly unsatisfied &
payed and not leaving behind him sufficient so-
nall Estate to satisfy the same whereby the said
John Whittington after the death of the said Miller
& Toacs the son & Executor became wholly Lyable to
Answer the said Debt of Thirty five thousand pounds
