

An Act Declaring severall acts of Parliament made in the Kingdom of England to be in force within this Province

Be it Enacted By the Queens most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and Consent of her Majestys Governour Councill and Assembly of this province and the authority of the same that the act of Parliament made at the Parliament begun and held at Westmister the nineteenth Day of March in the first year of the reigne of our Late Sovereigne Lord King James the first Intituled an act to restraine all persons from marriage untill their former wives and former husbands be Dead and the severall penall acts of parliament of England mentioned in the act of parliament made at the parliament held at westmister in the first year of the reigne of our late Sovereign Lord and Lady King William and Queen Mary Intituled an act for Exempting their Majestys Protestant Subjects Dissenting from the Church of England from the penaltys of certain laws together with the said Last mentioned act of Parliament Exempting their Majestys Protestant Subjects Dissenting from the Church of England from the penaltys of the said Laws & Every article Clause matter and thing in the said acts contained shall be & are in full force to all Intents & purposes within this Province
