An Act to Impower trustees to sell the freehold and Demesne Land of Abraham Naylor late of Annarundell County Deceased & apply the money to the uses mentioned in his Last Will and Testament

Whereas, Abraham Naylor late of Annarundell County planter Deceased was in his Lifetime seized in fee of One plantation & one hundred acres of Land or their abouts with the appurtenances lying on or near Herrin Creek in Annarundell County and by his last will and testament in writing he Did Devise that the said Plantation and Land should be sold by Samuel Chew & Nehemiah Birkhead of Annarundell County his trustees and Overseers by him nominated and appointed by that his Last will and Testament and what Remained of the purchase money after his Debts and Legacy were paid he did appoint to be Disposed of to the use and relief of poore people of the Quarter of U Stone In the parish of Dranfild in Darby Shires in the Kingdom of England for ever and whereas the said trustees in order to performe the said will have agreed to Bargaine and sell the said Plantation and Land to Christopher Vernon of Annarundell County
