An Act for advancement of trade
and erecting Ports & Towns in the Province
of Maryland

Be it enacted by the Queen's most excellent Majesty
By and with the advice and consent of her Majesty's Governour
Council and assembly of this province and the authority of the
same that from and after the end of this present session of
assembly the Towns ports and places herein after mentioned
shall be the ports and places where all ships and vessels
trading into this province shall unlade and put on shore all
Negroes Wares goods merchandises and Commodities whatsoever
(That is to say)
