And to it further made in the authority —
 Advice and Consent aforesaid that the Commissioners —
 herein before nominated and appointed for each
 respective County or the Major Part of them —
 are hereby empowered some time before the first
 day of September in the year of our Lord one —
 thousand seven hundred and five to meet together
 upon the respective lands and places in this Act —
 before mentioned or at some other convenient place
 near the said lands and there to view and agree
 with the Owners and persons interested in the said lands
 for One hundred acres of convenient Land at the
 discretion of the said Commissioners to be prejudicial
 to the Owners thereof —
 And after purchase thereof shall cause the same to be
 surveyed and laid out and after the same is surveyed
 shall cause the same One hundred
 acres of Land to be marked, staked out and divided
 into convenient streets lanes and alleys with open
 spaces to be left on which may be erected
 Church Stables and Market House and other publick
 Buildings and the remaining part of the said One hundred
 acres of Land as near as may be into One hundred equal
 Lots marked on some plans or plates towards the
 West
