tatives of the people in Assembly one other act passed Intituled
An Act for Suspending the prosecution of any priests of the
Communion of the Church of Rome incurring the penal-
tys of the said former act by exercising his function in
a private family of the Roman Communion but in no other
Case whatsoever for eighteen months or until her Majtys
pleasure therein known which said last act was ^{further} continued
for twelve months or her Majtys pleasure known by an act
to that purpose made at a session of Assembly held at the
Town and port of Annapolis the second day of April ^{Anno Domini} One
Thousand Seven hundred and six and both the said former
acts being taken into her Majtys Royal Consideration
out of her Gracious Genderness to all her Subjects behaving
themselves peaceably and quietly under her Majtys Govrn-
mt she has been graciously pleased by her order to his
Excellency the Governour of this province bearing date
at the Council board at Whitehall the Third day of Janry
one Thousand Seven hundred and five to Direct that anew
Law or Clause of a law should be enacted in this province
Whereby the said act of Assembly suspending the Execu-
tion of that part of the said first mentioned law for
preventing the growth of popery Vizt as to the prosecu-
tion of the said priests
