Seven hundred and five a certain Humphry Hubbard
was Deputy Comty of Dorchester County & had taken
the probat of severall Wills; Inventories of Estates &
accounts of Executors and administrators w^{ch} he carrying
over the bay to the Comty Generalls office lost by have-
ing his boat and the writings therein burnt but foras-
-much as he had Copy's of the Same w^{ch} he hath affirmed
by oath to be true and produced the Same before this
present Generalls assembly being as followeth (that
