

and the Naval officer to give a yearly permit to such a
Sloop Shallop boat or Vessel for the same for which
yearly sum the Naval officer shall take and receive -
for his fee the sum of two shillings and six pence &c
no more.

And be it further Enacted that
the Standard of weights and measures appointed
to be kept in the severall Countys of this province
shall from and after the first day of September one
Thousand Seven hundred and Eight be kept at such
Towns in the severall Countys of this province -
where the Court house of the said County shall be -
built which shall always be at such Town as is -
nearest the Center of the County and most Conve-
nient for the Inhabitants of the severall Countys
of this province (except only where the Court houses
are appointed by this act) and that no person or persons
whatsoever using any measures or weights shall
presume to sell any Commodities whatsoever by
such weights or measures or receive any Tobacco by
any Stiliards without trying them with the stand-
ard before they make use thereof according to the
Direction of the act of assembly Intituled an act
relating to the standard of English weights and
measures and incurring the penalties by the said -
act Imposed.

And forasmuch as many of the Inha-
bitants of this province live remote from Towns -
and cannot get their Tobacco either or Weighed -
