

Such Laying out of Ground for Forts and Publick
 Buildings with Streets Lanes and Allies shall be laid
 out and Divided into one hundred Lots (Saving the
 Rights of such Persons that have already built in
 The said Town) at the Discretion of the said Comysion
 and The said port and Town shall not be Extended or
 Laid out upon any Land but the Island onely anything
 in the said former Law to the Contrary Notwithstanding

And be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that
 from and after the first Day of January One thousand
 Seven hundred & Seven all high Sheriffs and Clerks
 of the County Courts shall be and are hereby obliged
 actually to reside and Inhabit in such port or Town
 where County Court houses are already built or to
 be built and if no Court house be in a Town or port
 Then such high Sheriffs and Clerks shall & are hereby
 obliged to reside and inhabit in such Town as shall be
 most Comodious to the inhabitants of such County under
 the penalty of one hundred pounds Sterling to our
 Sovereigne Lady the Queen to be divided one third to her
 said Majesty for the support of Government one third
 to the use of such port or Town where any such Court
 house shall be built and if the Court house is not
 Standing in any Town then to the use of the Town next
 Adjacent to the Court house and the other third to the
 Informer or him or them that sue for the same to be
 Recovered in any Court of Record within this province
 by bill plaint or Information wherein no Escoyn
 or Prolocution
