

Thousand two hundred fifty five pounds of tob^o and the
sume of four hundred seventy one pounds thirteen
shillings and four pence in money as by the said Journall
of accounts the same appears but because greater Charge
then what is already provided for and allowed will grow
due from the publick between this time and the tenth
day of October next Ensuing it is therefore humbly
prayed by this Generall Assembly, that it may be enacted

And be it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty
by and wth the advice and consent of her Majtys Govern^{or}
Councille and assembly of this province and the Authority
of the same that the severall persons hereafter named
(that is to say) Thomas Tench Esq, John Hammond Esq,
William Holland Esq, and James Sanders Esq, of her
Majty's hon^{or}ble Councille; And Wth W^m Asquith of
Saint Mary's County, Thomas Smyth Esq, of Kent
County, M^r Charles Greenberry of Annarundell
County, M^r Robert Skinner of Calvert County,
Jⁿ Contee Esq, of Charles County, M^r John Hall of
Baltimore County, M^r Nicholas Low of Talbott County,
M^r John Macclaster of Somerset County, M^r Hugh
Ecclestons of Dorchester County, M^r Edward Blay
of Cecil County, and M^r Thomas Greenfield of Prince
Georges County, or the greater part of them are
by this act appointed to meet together at the town
and port of Annapolis, the first Tuesday of October
next Ensuing then and there to apporcion the allow-
ances which are already made and allowed upon
the Journall of accounts and also to allow and
apporcion all such further Charges as shall appear
to them to be justly due and owing to any person or
persons from the publick. Provided that the same
publick Charges do not exceed one hundred thousand
pounds of tob^o and the sume of one thousand pounds.
