

And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid -
 Consent aforesaid that the aforesaid Trustees or such trustee or trustees
 make such sale as aforesaid shall apply the money arising by virtue
 of such sale towards payment and satisfaction of the said mortgage
 to the said John Hyde and to and for no other intent or purpose what-
 ever - And that upon payment or satisfaction of the said three pounds
 thirly four pounds four shillings and five pence sterling and interest
 to the said John Hyde or his assigns the said John Hyde his attorney or
 agent here shall give unto the said Trustees or any three of them a full and
 sufficient release or discharge for the same in full satisfaction and payment
 of the said Mortgage and that such release or discharge being recorded in
 the Secretary's office shall be a full and sufficient bar and revocation of the
 said Mortgage and shall dissolve and make void the same as fully and
 effectually to all intents and purposes as if the same had never been made or
 made any law statute usage or custom to the contrary notwithstanding -

And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid and consent aforesaid
 that from and after the payment and discharge of the said Mortgage
 the said Land called Major's Choice together with the said four Negroes -
 slaves heretofore mortgaged shall be settled and vested in the said Trustees to hold
 for the use and benefit of the said Christian Stirling and his heirs and assigns
 forever and the said four slaves shall not be accounted part or parcel of the
 personal estate of the said Thomas Stirling deceased nor payable to pay
 any of his debts but shall be acquitted and discharged therefrom and paid
 and not payable to any execution or attachment whatsoever passing to the
 said Sarah her heirs of the said Land called Major's Choice and Negroes
 aforesaid any law statute usage or custom to the contrary notwithstanding -

And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid and consent
 aforesaid that if it shall so happen that the said Sarah shall die before
 this province before the said Christian shall attain to full age or
 marriage that then the said Christian will have his Lands tenements and
 Negroes and all other things to her belonging or appertaining shall be
 under the guardianship or wardship of the said Wm Holland John
 Mackall and Richard Dallain Sancer one of them who are by her ad-
 constituted and appointed her guardian or guardians any law statute
 usage or custom to the contrary notwithstanding -
