

Discontinued by Her Majesty's

An Additional Act to the Supplement  
Act for advancement of Trade and Erecting Ports  
Townes in this province and for Sale of Some public  
Lands and Buildings in the Town of S<sup>t</sup>. Maries in  
Maries County.

Whereas Several Inhabitants of this province have humbly  
Suppliated His Excellency the Governour and this present  
Generall Assembly that for the better Convenience of Trade they  
may have some other Townes Erected and appointed in the sever-  
all Countys hereafter named and that Such Townes be Erected  
and constituted with the like priviledges as Townes heretofore  
have been Erected pursuant to an Act of Assembly intituled  
an act for advancement of Trade and Erecting ports and Townes  
in the province of Maryland made at an Assembly begun and held  
at the Port of Annapolis the Second Day of April one thousand  
Seven hundred and Six Therefore pray that it may be enacted -

And be it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent majesty  
by and with the advice and Consent of her majestys Governour Council  
and Assembly of this province and the authority of the same that  
the severall and Respective Commissioners hereafter named be and  
are by this act authorized and empowered to purchase and cause to be  
Surveyed laid out and divided into Lots the severall and Respective  
Lands herein after mentioned and appointed for Townes, according  
to the same Rules and Directions in the said Recited act contained  
on or before the Last Day of May next that is to say fifty acres of Land  
in King Georges Neck in Somerset County on the Land of John Waller fifty  
acres of Land in Queen Annes County at the mouth of Tuckahoe Creek  
on or near the Land of Colonel Nicholas Low fifty acres of Land at  
Chester Ferry or near the place where the old Court house stood in  
Kent County and fifty acres of Land at Shepherds old field near the head of  
Buttans Bay in S<sup>t</sup>. Maries County on the Land of Phillip Lynes Esq<sup>r</sup>  
which said Townes shall be laid out and divided into one hundred  
Lots according to the Discretion of the Commissioners hereafter  
named -

And to that End Be it Enacted by the authority  
advice and Consent aforesaid that for the Town in Somerset
