least requiring them to appear at your County Court house at a certain  
time not less than ten days after such proclamation made for electing  
and ~~choosing~~ <sup>putting</sup> Deputies and Delegates to serve for your said County in  
General Assembly to be holden at a ~~a~~ the ~~a~~ day of ~~a~~ <sup>to</sup> ~~to~~  
which time you shall adjourn your said Court and during the Court  
sitting the said freemen so required to appear or the major part of  
such of them as shall then appear shall and may and are hereby  
authorized and required to elect and choose four severall and suffi-  
cient men of your County each of them having a freehold of fifty acres of  
Land or a Visible Estate of forty pounds Sterling at the least within your  
County whether the parties so elected be present or absent the said election  
to be made in such manner and form as the Law of England and this  
Province does direct and provide and you are to incur the charge of the  
said persons elected in certain Indentures to be remade between  
you the said Sheriff and the Electors / that is to say two Indentures  
for each Delegat each Indenture having thereto you bind.
