

Seals and the said Seals of the Electors that the said
Deputies and Delegates for themselves and the County aforesaid
may have severally full & sufficient power to do and consent
to those things which then and there by the favour of God shall
happen to be ordained by the advice and consent of the great
Council of this province concerning such occasion and affairs
as shall relate to the government State and defence thereof
But we will not in any wise that you or any other Sheriff in
our said province be elected and that upon such Election you the
said Sheriff shall so soon as convenient may be give notice to
the parties elected if absent and certify and transmit to the
Chancellor of this province for the time being one of the two
severall and respective indentures affixed to these presents
sealed up and directed to the Chancellor of this province for the time
being and the other part of the said indentures you are to keep for
your justification Witness etc. And be it further enacted

by the authority aforesaid that the aforesaid four Delegates to be
elected in the respective Counties within this province be and are
hereby bound and obliged to attend the time and place of the meeting
of such Assemblies without any further writ or summons to be
them sent under the penalties of such fines as shall be by the said house
of Assembly imposed upon them unless upon sufficient cause to be
admitted by the said house of Assembly their absence be dispensed
withall any Law Usage or Custom to the contrary notwithstanding

PROVIDED also that no ordinary keeper within this
province during the time of his ordinary keeping or any other
person disabled by any Law of England from sitting in parliament
shall be elected chosen or serve as a Deputy or representative in
the said Generall Assembly to be hereafter called convened &
appointed as aforesaid. And be it further enacted by the
authority aforesaid that any Sheriff within this province
who shall not give speedy notice to the Inhabitants of his County
of the time and place where such Election shall be made as well
by proclamation as aforesaid and by causing the same to be
read at all Churches Chappels and other publick places within
his said County as also by notes thereof set up at such places
