An Act Confirming the Title of
a Certain Tract of Land therein mentioned to
John Hyde of the City of London Merchant and
also confirming unto the Heir at Law of John
Gandy late of the said City Mariner deceased
all other the Lands in this province in the said
Act mentioned

Whereas John Hyde of the City of London merchant and
Susannah Gandy Heir of John Gandy late of the said City
of London mariner for and on behalf of the Heir at Law of the
said John Gandy by their humble petition to the General Assembly
of this province have Represented that the above named John
Gandy did heretofore (viz) upon the Thirtieth day of August one
and seven hundred purchase of Richard Bourke late of the
said City of London Gentleman a Certain Tract of Land lying in
Chester River called Headbouene and containing one thousand acres
more or less originally taken up and granted to one George Head
the third of January in the year of our Lord one thousand six
hundred fifty nine and afterwards as it was supposed & calculated to be right
