An Act Confirming and Explain-

-ing the Charter to the City of Annapolis -

Whereas this present Generall Assembly have taken into their
Consideration the Charter lately granted to the City of Annapolis &
being desirous to give all due Encouragement to Habitation have
Resolved to Confirm the same Charter and to Explain and Restrain
some Clauses and Grants therein contained. They humbly pray that
they may be enacted. And it is hereby Enacted by the Queen's most
Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and Consent of her Majesty's
Governour Council and Assembly of this province and by the authority
of the same that the said Charter to the City of Annapolis bearing date
the said City on the Twentieth Second day of November anno 1708
Seven hundred and eight in the seventh year of her Majesty's
Sealed with the Great Seal of this her Majesty's province
with the Signe manuell of his Excellency John Seymour.
